

## Kevin Wayne Dimmick

October 31, 1956 - October 2, 2007

Kevin Dimmick, AIDS activist, founder of Positive Support, member of B.O.L.T. and medical pioneer died Tuesday October 2, 2007 at the age of 51.

Kevin served as a medic in the U.S. Army Rangers, took an A.A. degree in information technology from Contra Costa College, studied Choy Li Fut and taught at the Golden Dragon School of Martial Arts for many years, where he was Instructor of the Year in 1999 and 2000.

All who knew Kevin came into contact with his formidable intelligence, outrageous sense of humor, generosity, honesty, tenacity and courage. A family friend reckoned him "a force of nature."

He is survived by his wife, Barbara Welch of Vallejo, his mother and sister, Madge and Sharyn Dimmick of Kensington, and brother Bryan Dimmick of Richmond and beloved cat Ruffian.
